Resilient is a dynamic dance duet that is reflective on the coronavirus pandemic, the collective strength of humanity and the loss felt by the UK creative industry. It explores themes of struggle, passion and adaptability through movement as you see two people work tirelessly to find a sense of hope and salvation despite the current circumstance. REWIND & REPLAY

PETER TWYMAN DANCE EDINBURGH

The work delves into the mind where the start is and the end and how just one meeting can fragment the mind into turmoil. Audiences will experience a glimpse of this turmoil swept up in the emotion and chaos created when the mind is broken.

Following training at the Scottish School of Contemporary Dance in Dundee, Peter Twyman CBTS RAD completed his BPA(Hons) at the NSCD in Leeds. Peter began teaching in Edinburgh in 2006 and has taught on the RAD Boys Only! Weekend Workshop since 2010. He has worked with the Royal Ballet, Dutch National Ballet, Frankfort Ballet, Canadian Opera Company, Scottish Ballet, Scottish Dance Theatre and the White Oak Dance Company on their summer courses and workshops. Regularly choreographing dances for our shows, Peter also works with Edinburgh Ballet Circle, organises local charity events for McDonald's and choreographs the junior and senior displays with Kestrel Gymnastics Club who tour and compete throughout the UK. Peter has also performed with Edinburgh's charitable amateur dance and dramatic organisations, including Tempo, The Bohemians, Showcase and Southern Light Orchestra in shows such as the King & I, Wizard of Oz and West Side Story.

SEHNSUCHT

LOST MOVEMENT COMPANY ITALY

Sehnsucht is a key word of the German romantic spirit which embodies one of the typical concepts of the romantic culture, rendered in English with "addiction to desire". Heidegger identifies its meaning in pain: "Nostalgia (Sehnsucht) is the pain of the proximity of the distant". Sehnsucht means reaching the limit which separates us from the others, finding it, showing it, touching it. Lonely but dependent bodies investigate, in a common space, their own limits in relation to body, space, time and relationships.

The music has the role of defining and expanding the limits of the space designed by the dancers. The performance tries to overcome the choreographic case itself, through an instant composition that becomes different every time. The internal relationships slowly reveal themselves from the flow of movement, questioning the concept of limit. Inside this system, the bodies look for and find each other, exploring a new kind of contact, a new way of living the relationship in which the audience recognizes itself, living the performative act with hope and greed.



'Footprint' is a new work-in-progress dance piece combining movement, text and visual elements, made not only in response to the climate crisis, but in reference to how phrases can be turned around to take on other meanings and ultimately draw us away from engaging meaningfully, and with care and love for our natural world.

Concerned with the changes occuring in our world right now, she created 'Burnt Out' in response to the devastating Australian Black Summer fires which went on to tour Scotland.
